- •Pencil







### Directions:


- I. Print the camp sign template (page 3) on cardstock paper.
- Print the mini book pages (pages 4-6).
- 3. Have students fill out the mini book pages using words and/or pictures. This is best done after reading a camping themed book, discussing what it is like to go camping as a class, or as a closing activity to end your camping unit.
- 4. Students can now color their camp sign.
- 5. Cut out the camp sign and mini book pages.
- 6. Staple the mini book onto the sign.

<u>Optional</u>: To extend this activity, use the camping themed writing sheets (pages 7 & 8). Students can use ideas from their mini book to write a creative story about camping.
