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


To use booklet: Print, cut, and staple! Then, have students color and fill out their booklets using the word list provided.




\*\*\*For students who might need it, I have also included the sequencing steps already in the correct order.





To make the foldable: take 2 sheets of paper, fold them in half (hamburger), staple twice at the top.














A female frog lays many eggs.

The tail shrinks and the tadpole grows into a frog.

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
