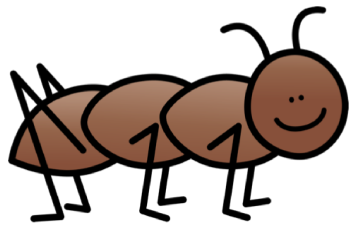


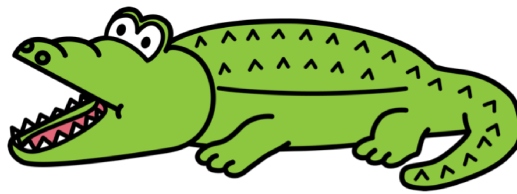
Comprehension Questions Field of 3

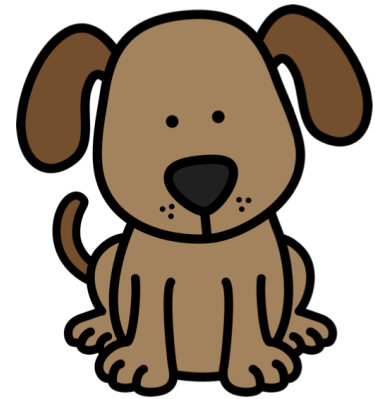

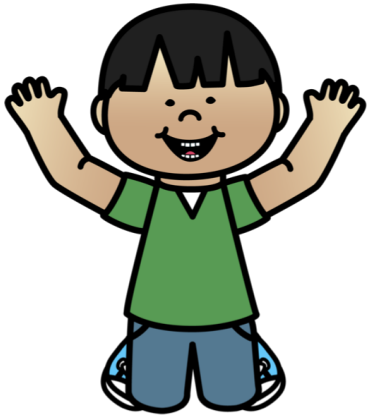

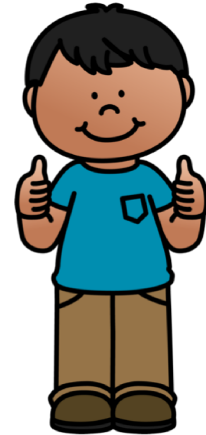

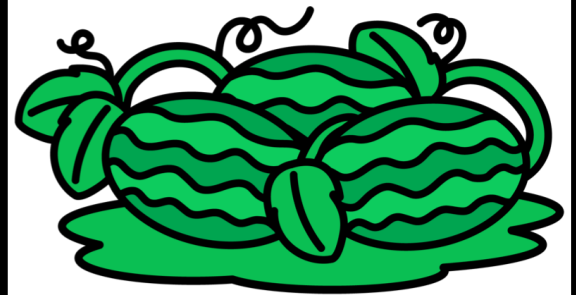
